

## Estimated Minimum Expenses UCSF Medical Center Dietetic Internship

- There is no tuition for our internship program.
- Interns do not need an automobile for any required learning experience in the internship.
- UCSF Dietetic Interns are covered for professional liability while performing University-related duties. Coverage is provided by the Regents of the University of California Self-Insurance Program. Any activities outside internship assignments are not covered.
- Uniforms are not required for any learning experiences in the internship.

Minimum expenses assume that interns live within walking distance of hospital <sup>4</sup> , share housing, and eat meals at the hospital when on duty.

<sup>2</sup> Health Insurance, medical care and dental care are provided to the intern through UCSF Student Health Services (SHS). Information about medical coverage provided by SHS can be obtained on the SHS website: [shs.ucsf.edu](http://shs.ucsf.edu). Pre-existing health problems are not covered. For dental coverage, Student Health Insurance covers 80% for preventative services and 50% basic services; overall costs are lowered if intern visits an in-network clinic ([firstdentalhealth.com](http://firstdentalhealth.com)).

<sup>3</sup> Upon completion of the internship, the account balance may be paid to intern as a taxable lump sum, or may be rolled into another tax-deferred retirement account.

<sup>4</sup> If interns plan to commute by bus from a location within San Francisco, a monthly bus pass is \$55. Public transportation from locations outside of San Francisco would be significantly more expensive.
